

Cosc Consultation Forum on Second National Strategy on Domestic, Sexual and Gender-based Violence

Cosc recently completed a review of the First National Strategy on Domestic, Sexual and Gender-based Violence. A team from the University of Limerick analysed the submissions received on foot of a questionnaire seeking feedback on the current National Strategy and input for the development of the Second National Strategy on domestic, sexual and gender-based violence. The analysis has synthesised the views of those who made submissions and is organised around six themes identified by the researchers from the text analysed. In order to assist with the drafting process for the Second National Strategy Cosc invited relevant stakeholders to attend a consultation forum Dublin Castle on Monday the 17th of November 2014 to help decide on priorities for the new strategy.
